### Master's in Nursing

48-credit degree program to prepare graduates for roles as Advanced Practice Nurses (APNs)

Family and Adult/Gerontological Nurse Practitioners (NP) and Acute/Critical Care Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS)

### Post Master's Certificate (online)

12 or 21-credit options to prepare Family and Adult/Gerontological Nurse Practitioners (NP)

### PhD in Nursing

60-credit post-master's degree program and 87-credit post-baccalaureate degree program

Program focus is on the intersection of nursing and health policy preparing nurses for the roles of analyst, researcher and educator
